## Mittens and Toque



## Materials

- Two colours of yarn
- A-Grey
- B-Blue
- Two crochet hooks
- Size U.S. 7 4.5 mm
- Size J 6.00 mm
- Needle
- Fabric for lining


## Abbreviations

Chain - ch
Single crochet - sc
single 2 together - Sc2tog
Stitch(es) - St(s)
fasten off - FO
slip stitch - SI st
space(s) - Sp(s)
Magic loop - ML
Round(s) - Rnd(s)
Half double crochet - Hdc Right side - RS

## Instructions

## Mitts (Make 2)



## Gauge: 14 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm

With A and smaller crochet hook, ch 34
Row 1: (RS). sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, sc in each ch to end of ch, Turn. (33 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row, Turn.
Rep last row 6 times more.
At the last row change to $B$
Shape thumb gusset:
Row 1: (RS), Ch 1, sc in each of first 17 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each st to end of row, Turn. ( 37 sts )

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row, Turn.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 17 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to end of row, Turn. (39 sts)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row, Turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each of first 17 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to end of row, Turn. (41 sts)
Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row, Turn.
Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each of first 17 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to end of row, Turn. (43 sts)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row, Turn.

## Change to $A$

Row 9: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 17 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to end of row, Turn. (45 sts)

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row, Turn.
Row 11: Ch 1, sc in each of first 17 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to end of row. Turn. (47 sts)
Row 12: Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row, Turn.
Row 13: Ch 1, sc in each of first 17 sts, ch 2, Skip next 14 sts, sc in each st to end of row. Turn. (31 sts plus ch2 sp )

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in each st or ch 1 sp to end of row. 33 sts.

Body of the mitt
Rows $1-2$ : ch 1 , sc in each st across, turn.

## Change to B

Rows 3 - 10: ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.
Change to A
Shape top:
Row 1: (RS). Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 11 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 11 sts, sc2tog, sc in last st, Turn. (29 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 9 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 9 sts, sc2tog, sc in last st, Turn. (25 sts)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 7 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 7 sts, sc2tog, sc in last st, Turn. (21 sts)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 5 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 5 sts, sc2tog, sc in last st, Turn. (17 sts)
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in last st, Turn. (13 sts)

Put on your hand and put it over your hand with thumb in thumb gusset. Rep for other hand. Sew together with A on the opening leaving top open

Thumb:
With RS facing, join B with sl st to ch sp.

Rnd 1: Ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 14 sts, Join with sl st to first sc, ( 16 sts )

Rnds 2 - 5: Ch 1, 1 sc in each sc around, Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, (Sc2tog) 8 times, Join with sl st to first st, (8 sts)

Rnd 7: Ch 1 . (Sc2tog) 4 times. (4 sts) FO. Thread end through a tapestry needle and draw yarn through rem sts. Fasten securely.

## Lining

Repeat steps on this site: Here
Sew the top shut
Touque


Gauge: 11 hdc and 5 rnds = 4" [10 cm ]
Hat

Rnd 3: (2 hdc in first st, hdc in the next st) around, join, ch 1 (24 sts)

Rnd 4: (2 hdc in first st, hdc in the next 2 sts) around, join, ch 1 (32 sts)

Change to $B$
Rnd 5: (2 hdc in first st, hdc in the next 3 sts) around, join, ch 1 (40 sts)

Rnd 6: (2 hdc in first st, hdc in the next 4 sts) around, join, ch 1 (48 sts)
Rnd 7: (2 hdc in first st, hdc in the next 5 sts ) around, join, ch 1 ( 56 sts)

Change to A
Rnds 8 - 9: hdc in each st around, join, ch 1 (56 sts)
Change to $B$
Rnds 10 - 11: hdc in each st around, join, ch 1 (56 sts)
Change to $A$
Rnds 12 - 19: hdc in each st around, join, ch 1 (56 sts)
Rnd 20: sc in each st around, join, FO.
Weave tail in

With A and larger crochet hook
Rnd 1: Make a ML, 8hdc in ring, join with sl st (8 sts)
Rnd 2: 2 hdc each st around, join, ch 1 (16 sts)

Pom-pom (https://hearthookhome.com/different-methods-making-pom-poms/)

1. MAKING POM POMS WITH TOILET PAPER ROLLS


This method makes large pom poms. You're going to lay two empty toilet paper rolls together. Wrap yarn around and around and around the two tubes until you've got a good amount of yarn. Take another piece of yarn (about a foot long should suffice) and work it between the two tubes and tie a tentative knot. Gently push the yarn toward one end of the tube, being careful to hold onto both ends of the yarn you're using to securely tie the pom pom together. Once the yarn is off the tubes, tie it tight toilet paper rolls were previously).


Trim to form and voila! Done.
2. MAKING POM POMS WITH A FORK


Using a fork, wrap yarn around all tines. Wrap and wrap and wrap until you get the desired amount of yarn. Now you'll thread another piece of the yarn through the center tines, and tie a secure knot. Gently pull the yarn off of the fork and cut up both sides to create the pom pom. Trim to form and voila! Done.
3. MAKING POM POMS WITH YOUR HAND


Basically the same idea as the concepts above. Simply wrap around and around your hand until you get enough yarn. Gently pull the yarn off of your hand, wrap another piece around the center of the yarn ball. Tie it tight to secure, cut up both sides. Trim to form and voila! Done.
