#### Assessments:

## Procedures:

The procedures for this lesson are:

1. I would introduce the project and explain what they will be doing.

#### WA 10/20:

1. They will choose a word that has a personal connection with the word.

- 2. They will choose a medium that they want to create the word. Parameters of the medium:
  - a. You cannot use text tools (Online only) to create your word. It has to be done by hand.
  - b. The medium should be easily identified and be able to calculate perimeter, area, volume, and mass.
- 3. They will also need to bring all of their materials for the chosen Medium that they want to do.

## WA 10:

- 4. They will use graph paper (found in Worksheet 3) to first design the word and then they can also use a scale to figure out the Area, and volume for their word.
- 5. Using WA10 Creation of a Font: Timecard they will record how much time they worked on their project.

WA 20:

- 3. They will use graph paper (found in Worksheet 1: Scale) to start designing their word.
- 4. They will also determine a scale factor between the two mediums.
